


The New Jersey Virtual School has moved to a new registration and logon server. Your classes are still the same, but there is a different way to access them now. Please follow the steps below to logon to your class.

1. Click the “Click here to logon to your courses” link on [www.njvs.org/login.aspx](http://www.njvs.org/login.aspx). On the next page enter in your username and password. Your user id and password have not changed; they are the same as the ones you’ve already been using.


ATTENTION ALL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS
